

Community Relations Policy



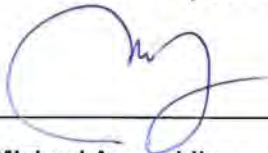
In the relationship with host communities, West African Ventures Limited (WAV) commits to;
